A press release aims to generate media coverage for your organization's participation in National Crime Victims' Rights Week and other events throughout the year. Edit this sample press release to reflect specific community issues and highlight activities, events, and commemorations. Share the release with your contacts and local media, but don't forget to post it on your website, link to it on social media, and share the link. Use this opportunity to generate exposure for your organization, highlight issues related to your mission, and position your spokesperson as an expert. Distribute your release at least 10 days before your event for the best results. Use the lead time to follow up with reporters and partner organizations, identify spokespeople, answer questions, and create media materials for each significant event.

Five Elements of a Noteworthy Press Release

- 1. Craft an attention-grabbing headline.
- 2. Include the main point in the first paragraph, and address who, what, when, where, and why.
- 3. Use relevant statistics.
- 4. Incorporate at least one firm quote to engage your reader.
- 5. Include contact information and additional resources.
