

The Role of OVC





Important Reminder About Cooperative Agreements



Cooperative Agreement = Substantial OVC Involvement



Responsibility for day-to-day project operations rests with recipient in implementing approved proposal, approved budget, and terms and conditions specified in award.



Responsibility for general oversight and redirection of the project, if necessary, rests with OVC.



TTA Overview

- OVC provides practitioner-driven, evidence-based TTA that is responsive to the particular needs of victim service providers and system stakeholders, their communities, and the victims they serve.
- Technical assistance providers strengthen the victim assistance responses to human trafficking, support multidisciplinary task forces and cross-sector collaboration, and build stakeholder capacity and leadership in identifying human trafficking victims and connecting them to services.



OVC's TTA Providers work together to support OVC Human Traficking Grantees via unique TTA specializations and expertise.





Collaborate

OVC Programmatic TTA Provider

These providers are assigned to a specific OVC anti-trafficking grantee cohort, like Services for Victims of Human Trafficking and Preventing Trafficking in Girls. They will contact their grantees regularly.



OVC Specialized TTA Provider

These providers have a focus area, like survivor engagement or legal services. OVC anti-trafficking grantees may contact these providers as the need arises, but eligibility varies.



OVC Operational Support TTA Provider

These providers are part of the training and technical assistance arm of OVC, including the Performance
Management Team and the Financial
Management Resource
Center, and are available to all OVC anti-trafficking grantees.

Program TTA	Specialized TTA	Operational Support TTA
Dedicated cohort of grantees, # and type differing based on program.	OVC HT grantees across programs can access this TTA, however eligibility differs per scope of work.	Contracts designed to support OVC in helping grantees meet grant requirements.
Scope of work focused specifically FOR the support of an OVC HT program and the grantees within that program.	Scope of work is typically focused ON creation of specific resource or support in area of ongoing need.	Scope of work is focused on an area of need related to meeting administrative and financial requirements of the OVC HT program.
Ensures grantees within program are up to date on information from OVC and the field. Works with Specialized TTA providers on referrals.	OVC grantees proactively request this TTA. Works with Program TTA providers to ensure grantees aware of opportunities.	Supports OVC to help ensure grantees meet administrative and financial requirements of their award.

The 3 C's and OVC

Communication

- Set up check-ins with your OVC grant manager
- Discuss ideas for project amendments and timelines
- Ask questions to clarify!

Collaboration

- Participate in OVC TTA provider meetings (in person annually and virtual quarterly)
- Include time for grant manager to provide meaningful input in resource development and review.
 - Ask your grant manager what this looks like for them!

Coordination

OVC will work with TTA providers to amend scope if TTA overlap or duplication is identified



The 3 C's and Other TTA Providers

Communication

- Discuss scope of work, target audience, and limitations of each provider.
- Work with the appropriate TTA POC to contact grantees.
- Honor different views and challenges with openness and honesty and consider how these differences and challenges may impact the development and delivery of TTA.

Collaboration

- Invite Specialized TTA providers to program-specific webinars and/or meetings as appropriate.
- Reach out to Program TTA providers to share new resources or upcoming opportunities.
- Create spaces to promote physical and psychological safety for fellow TTA providers, collaborators, and recipients when participating in TTA.

Coordination

- Share trainings on TAC calendar to help others avoid duplication or conflict AND to maximize impact!
- Utilize existing valued resources.



The 3 C's and Grantees

Communication

- Respond to grantee requests in a timely manner.
- Actively listen!
- Share concerns promptly with OVC.
- Honor different views and challenges with openness and honesty and consider how differences and challenges may impact the development and delivery of TTA.

Collaboration

- Schedule peer-to-peer learning opportunities
- Inform grantees about the TTA provider's collaboration with OVC and the roles of the TTA provider.
- Create spaces to promote physical and psychological safety for fellow TTA providers, collaborators, and recipients when participating in TTA.

Coordination

 Connect grantees with other TTA providers for specialized TTA.



Additional OVC TTA Guidance

 Implement policies and procedures that incorporate persons with lived experience and expertise into the design, development, and TTA delivery process in a meaningful and equitable way.

OVC HTD TTA Resource Materials

Submitting Materials – Award Conditions

The grantee agrees to comply with the requirements set forth in the current edition of the OVC Publishing Guidelines Handbook.

TTA providers agree to:

- Submit to OVC for review and approval <u>any product</u> that will be developed and published under this award, 60 days before its intended publication.
- Correct a product in response to comments as otherwise requested by OVC.
- Include DOJ disclaimer language.
- The <u>OVC grant manager</u> will determine whether minor deliverables, such as webinars, onepage flyers and discrete web pages, require review or prior approval by OVC.



Submitting Materials – OVC Expectations

- Use existing, publicly available material when possible and avoid duplication. Include citations as appropriate.
- Use the federal Trafficking Victims Protection Act definition of human trafficking.
- Develop victim-centered and trauma-informed content.
- Comply with accessibility requirements.
- Adhere to review and approval requirements in the OVC award conditions.
- Review, evaluate, and update materials based on feedback.
- Required disclaimer language on all materials; this includes webpages developed in part or fully with grant funds.
- See award conditions and be sure to share will all staff working on your OVC-funded initiative.



Submitting Materials – OVC Expectations



Discuss with your OVC grant manager how and when they prefer to review materials for approval

Email and then in JGS or directly in JGS?

How many days in advance?



Review content before sending to OVC

Spelling, grammar, formatting, and accessibility compliance should be addressed prior to sending your documents to OVC for review.



Make sure all deliverables are in JGS for record-keeping


